As you place this ring on **Gregors** finger please repeat after me: With this ring, I thee wed,/ and pledge my everlasting love.

**Anja** and **Gregor** will now share a glass of wine symbolizing the sharing of their lives now and the sharing they will experience together for the rest of their lives.

And now in as much as **Anja** and **Gregor** have consented together in wedlock and have witnessed the same before this company of family and friends
